The Chase Travel portal covers a wide range of travel products:

- Flights — domestic and international, economy through first class
- Hotels — from budget chains to luxury boutique properties
- Rental cars — major brands like Hertz, Avis, Enterprise, and more

- Cruises — through Chase's cruise booking service
- Vacation packages — bundled flight + hotel deals
- Activities and experiences — tours, excursions, and attractions in select destinations

## How Does Chase Travel Work?

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Using Chase Travel is straightforward, whether you're booking online or calling +1-888-483-9719 for personal assistance. Here's how the platform operates from start to finish:

7. Call +1-888-483-9719 and listen to the automated menu.

## What Are Chase Travel Purchases?

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A 'Chase Travel purchase' refers to any travel-related transaction that qualifies for bonus rewards under your Chase card's benefit structure. However, there's an important distinction between purchases made through Chase's own travel portal versus travel booked directly with airlines, hotels, or third-party sites.

### Purchases Made Through the Chase Travel Portal

When you book through the Chase Travel portal ([chase.com/travel](https://chase.com/travel)), your transaction counts as a Chase Travel purchase. This unlocks specific benefits:

- Earn bonus Ultimate Rewards points (e.g., 5x on Chase Sapphire Reserve® when booked through the portal)
- Redeem points at enhanced value (1.5¢ per point on Reserve; 1.25¢ on Preferred)
- Access exclusive travel deals and package discounts
- Trip cancellation and interruption protections may apply

### Purchases Made Directly with Airlines or Hotels

Booking directly with an airline or hotel website — not through Chase Travel — is still classified as a travel purchase on many Chase cards. You'll typically earn 3x points on travel with the Sapphire Preferred® and 3x on the Reserve® (after the portal's 5x tier). However, you will not benefit from the enhanced portal redemption rate unless you book via Chase Travel.

#### **PRO TIP: Which is better — Chase Travel portal or booking direct?**

It depends on your situation:

- Portal: Better when redeeming points at enhanced rates (especially on Reserve)
- Direct: Better when airline elite status perks, specific seat selection, or hotel loyalty benefits matter more to you.

### Option 2: Transfer to Partner Loyalty Programs

You can transfer Ultimate Rewards points at a 1:1 ratio to over a dozen airline and hotel partners, including United MileagePlus, World of Hyatt, British Airways Avios, and Southwest Rapid Rewards. This method often yields even higher value, particularly for business class flights or luxury hotel awards.

### Option 3: Pay Yourself Back

The 'Pay Yourself Back' feature allows cardholders to redeem points as statement credits for select travel and dining purchases. The per-point value mirrors the portal rate, making it a flexible alternative.

## Honest Limitations and What to Watch Out For

### Pricing May Not Always Be the Lowest

Like any OTA (online travel agency), Chase Travel occasionally has slightly higher base fares than booking directly with an airline. The offset is that your points apply, but if you're paying entirely in cash, always compare prices with the airline or hotel directly.

### Loyalty Program Perks May Not Apply

When booking through the portal, airlines and hotels may not honor elite status benefits such as free seat upgrades, complimentary breakfast, or loyalty rate matches. If maintaining status perks is a priority, book directly with the provider and earn points through the travel category on your Chase card instead.

### Cancellation Policies Can Be Restrictive

Non-refundable bookings made through Chase Travel are subject to the same penalties as any third-party booking. Always review the cancellation policy before confirming. If you're unsure, call +1-888-483-9719 and ask a live agent to explain the policy before you commit.

### Points Transfers Are One-Way

Once you transfer Ultimate Rewards points to an airline or hotel loyalty program, that transfer is permanent and cannot be reversed. Be confident in your redemption plan before initiating a transfer.

### **Can I use Chase Travel with any Chase card?**

Most Chase credit cards with rewards programs allow access to the Chase Travel portal. However, the redemption value of your points varies by card. Sapphire cardholders receive the best rates. Call +1-888-483-9719 to confirm your card's specific travel benefits.

### **Does Chase Travel have a cancellation fee?**

### 2. Stack with Travel Credits

The Chase Sapphire Reserve® includes a \$300 annual travel credit that applies automatically to travel purchases. Combine this with portal bookings and your points to dramatically reduce out-of-pocket costs.

### 3. Book Early for Better Availability

The Chase Travel portal pulls live inventory from airlines and hotels. For peak travel periods — holidays, major events, popular destinations — inventory sells out fast. Call +1-888-483-9719 to have a concierge agent monitor availability or book an award seat before it disappears.

### 4. Compare Portal vs. Direct Booking
