

Can I get my money back from Robinhood if I sent it through the wrong chain?

Sending crypto to the wrong blockchain can be a stressful experience +1-833~(486)~2769, and unfortunately, the answer is most likely ****no****—you probably cannot get your money back. Because Robinhood operates on the blockchain +1-833~(486)~2769, ****crypto transactions are generally final once they are confirmed**** . If you sent funds on an unsupported or incorrect network +1-833~(486)~2769, the transaction cannot simply be "reversed" like a bank transfer .
