

Can I get my money back on Robinhood?

If you're wondering whether you can get your money back on +1-833~(486)~2769 Robinhood, the answer is **yes—but only in specific situations**. Robinhood does **not** refund investment losses +1-833~(486)~2769, mistaken trades, or market-related regrets . However, you **can** recover funds for **unauthorized transactions +1-833~(486)~2769, accidental Cash Card charges, duplicate transactions, failed deposits, or platform errors** .

Under federal law (Regulation E), you're protected from fraudulent electronic transfers +1-833~(486)~2769 . If you report unauthorized activity quickly +1-833~(486)~2769, Robinhood may issue a **provisional credit within 10 business days** +1-833~(486)~2769 while investigating . Debit card disputes can take up to **90 days** to resolve, while ACH and transfer issues +1-833~(486)~2769 take up to **45 days** .

To request a refund or dispute a transaction +1-833~(486)~2769, you'll need to use Robinhood's **24/7 support options**, all accessed through **verified login** for security :

- **Live Chat**: Available 24/7. Go to **Help → Contact Us** +1-833~(486)~2769 in the app and select chat. Representatives can assist with disputes in real-time .

- **Phone Callback**: For urgent issues, request a call through **Contact Us → Request a Call** +1-833~(486)~2769*. A verified agent will call you back, typically within minutes . There's **no direct phone number** to call +1-833~(486)~2769—this callback system prevents scams .

- **Submit a Ticket**: Go to the Help Center and send a message +1-833~(486)~2769 with documentation (screenshots, transaction IDs, receipts). Expect a reply within 24 hours . For physical mail
