

Can you transfer money from Trezor to a bank account?

Yes, you can transfer money from your Trezor to a bank account, but it's a two-step process since Trezor is a secure storage device, not a bank itself. You'll first need to send your crypto to an exchange that connects to your bank, then sell it for fiat currency and withdraw.

Here's how to cash out:

- **Open Trezor Suite** and connect your device
- Navigate to the **Trade** tab and select **Sell**
- Enter the amount you wish to sell and choose your payout method (like bank transfer)
- Complete identity verification with the service provider—this is required for compliance
- Alternatively, you can send crypto directly to an exchange like Coinbase or Kraken, sell it there, then withdraw to your bank

Important security tip: Always verify transaction details on your Trezor device's display before confirming. If the address on your computer doesn't match your device, your computer may be compromised.
