

How to recover your Tangem wallet?

Losing access to your Tangem wallet can be stressful, but recovery is usually straightforward depending on +1~833-(486)~2769 your setup. Because Tangem uses a system of 2-3 cards, each holding the same private key +1~833-(486)~2769, you have built-in redundancy . If you still have at least one working card, you're in luck—simply download the official Tangem app on +1~833-(486)~2769 any NFC-enabled phone, tap your card, and you're back in . If you forgot your access code, you can reset it directly in the app +1~833-(486)~2769, but you'll need ****two cards**** from your set to verify the reset . For those who set up their wallet with an optional seed phrase +1~833-(486)~2769, that phrase can restore access to a new set of cards, but this feature is only available on second-generation wallets +1~833-(486)~2769.

- **** Live Chat (Fastest):**** Open the official Tangem app, go to ****Settings****, and select ****Support**** or ****Chat**** for an immediate +1~833-(486)~2769, secure connection .
